Conditions of play, course etiquette and smoking laws

1. Always ensure all players in the group ahead and all other players are at a safe distance before playing any shot. Do not hit up until players are out of range.
2. Please leave the golf course if there are storms and/or lightning in the area, if instructed by course staff or upon hearing the storm siren/horn.
3. No more than four players are permitted to play together.
4. Every player must have a set of clubs and be correctly attired.
5. Please carry a sand bucket and replace divots.
6. Always smooth out your foot holes etc. in bunkers.
7. It is desirable that slower players invite faster players through.
8. Golfers must take direction from course staff at all times.
9. Carts must be driven with care. Drivers must have a current driver licence.
10. Carts must obey all direction signs and must be kept at least 10 metres from green.
11. Due to Queensland Government legislation, smoking regulations apply on this site. Smoking is only permitted in the main car parking areas, in areas defined as smoking areas and on the golf course tee-off areas (level tops). Food and drinks cannot be served or consumed in the areas where smoking is permitted.

Local rules

To be read in conjunction with *Rules of Golf*.

- Out of bounds (Rule 18.2):**
 - Beyond any fence bounding the course.
 - Beyond any line of white stakes with black tops and/or white lines.
 - Clubhouse and driveway, driving range, car park and practise putting green.
 - Beyond the driving range fence.
- Abnormal course conditions (including immovable obstructions) (Rule 16):**
 - All artificially surfaced roads and paths including raised concrete edging.
 - All staked trees and shrubs. Must take one club length free relief no nearer the hole. Rule 14.3.
 - All stakes (excluding 00B stakes), safety screens, bridges, distance markers, tee signage, tee markers, timber edging and retaining walls, ball washers, fixed rubbish bins, sand bins, irrigation control boxes, drains and fixed signs. One card length free relief. Rule 14.3.
 - All fixed sprinkler heads and tap covers are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained under Rule 24. In addition, if such an obstruction on, or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty.
- Ground under repair (GUR) (Rule 16):**
 - Includes all areas bounded by white stakes and/or white lines.
 - All marked and unmarked irrigation and construction works.
 - All tyre marks made by machinery.
 - Bare patches – a ball which comes to rest on a bare patch (area devoid of grass – a divot is not a bare patch) through the green, may take relief at the nearest point, no nearer the hole.
 - All garden beds fully enclosed by a brick, concrete, rock or timber border.
- Loose impediments in bunkers (Rule 12.2a and 12.2b):**
 - Loose impediments or stones in bunkers may be removed without penalty.
